





Hello Vamsi! It's a pleasure to have you here. Your journey as an actor is truly fascinating, just like your new series, "Sweet Kaaram Coffee." Can

you share some highlights and twists from your career, from pursuing an MBA to managing a betting store in London? Please tell us more!

The Early Days

Well, early on, I was in a strict school environment, and academics weren't exactly my forte. But then I pursued my graduation at GITAM and made some cherished friends during my college years in Vizag. However, the real turning point came when I decided to go for an MBA in London. That's when I discovered my passion for creativity and agency. I could finally explore subjects and projects that truly ignited my fire, like working at Yorkshire TV and running a betting store in Edgeware Road.

Serendipity

It was back in 2003 when I got a call from Yorkshire TV offering me a full-time role while I was in India. But here's the interesting part – the flight I was on got diverted due to a cyclone, and during my unplanned stay at the airport, I struck up a conversation with a man named Gautham. Turns out, he was Director Gautham Menon, and that chance encounter led to him casting me in my first film, "Gharshana." Talk about serendipity, right?

Support

It was challenging for my parents initially to accept my career choice, given their background as well-established doctors. They had this belief in the conventional path of education leading to a secure and successful career, you know, the usual doctor, engineer, or corporate job. So, my decision to pursue acting deviated quite a bit from their expectations. Regardless, I received financial support and encouragement from my parents. They gave me just enough money to meet my basic needs.

They did this to avoid complacency and that pushed me to work hard.

My wife, Paro, is a teacher who works in Hyderabad. She was there by me during my poorest times! Like literally 50 rupees in the house and four days to go till the next penny comes in. We used to laugh our way through it. I now shuttle between Hyderabad and Chennai - wherever my work takes me.

Honing the Skills

Training has been a crucial part of my journey. I had the opportunity to work with veteran Indian acting coach, Satyanand, which encouraged me to shed inhibitions and explore my abilities. Later, I attended an acting course at the Stella Adler Academy of Acting in LA, where I learned a more subtle and natural approach to acting, focusing on delivering lines without overtly "acting." Both experiences have shaped my perspective and understanding of acting techniques.

Tollywood vs Kollywood – The Difference

Oh, they're quite distinct in their creative approaches. The Telugu industry tends to be more star-driven, while the Tamil industry is more story-driven. Working in both has given me exposure to different creative environments and demands. I've had the chance to work with directors with varying styles, some more prescriptive, and others giving creative freedom, which has been a well-rounded experience for me.



The Journey

It's not always smooth sailing in the film industry. One of my films, "Oka Vichitram," didn't perform well at the box office, but I didn't let that discourage me. I embraced diverse roles in Telugu films, positive, negative, and small ones, which showcased


State Warriors.

The Buddha Stupa is an ancient masterpiece of architecture and devotion, standing tall at a height of 36 meters (118 feet). Its colossal white dome is adorned with vibrant prayer

flags fluttering in the breeze, creating a mesmerizing sight against the backdrop of the Kathmandu skyline. The stupa is crowned with a gilded spire, or harmika, which is adorned with the watchful eyes of Lord Buddha, symbolizing his allseeing wisdom. Devout Buddhists, monks, and visitors from all walks of life gather here to circumambulate the stupa in a clockwise direction, spinning prayer wheels as they pass. This practice, known as kora, is a symbolic representation of the Buddhist path and a way to accumulate merit. In 2015, a devastating earthquake shook Nepal, causing widespread destruction. The Buddha Stupa, though damaged, remained standing tall, serving as a symbol of strength and resilience for the nation.



My next stop is a 15-minute drive from the stupa, Pasupatinath Temple situated on the banks of the sacred Bagmati River in the capital city of Kathmandu, this temple holds immense religious and cultural significance for Hindus around the world. This holy Hindu temple is dedicated to Lord Shiva, the destroyer and transformer within the Hindu pantheon. According to Hindu mythology, the temple is believed to be

one of the 52 Shakti Peeths, where body parts of the goddess Sati fell when Lord Shiva carried her charred remains after her self-immolation.

No exploration of Nepal would be complete without indulging in its delectable street food. The bustling streets of Kathmandu were a treasure trove of culinary delights. From momos

(dumplings) to sel roti (a sweet rice bread), each bite offered a burst of flavours that tantalized my taste buds. 


